Eligibility: If you are an undergraduate enrolled at the University of Michigan—Dearborn for at least six credit hours during the Fall 2009, Winter 2010 or Summer 2010 terms, you are eligible to enter the competition. You may submit work in more than one category, but only one entry per category. You are eligible to win a first-place award in only one

category. Winning a first-place award in a category makes you ineligible to enter that category in subsequent years. All entries must be original work; for collaboratively-authored projects include names of all authors on entry form. Entries may not have been previously published (except in student publications).

Winners will be notified by June 25, 2010.
